

Integrity of the HRC Website and HRC Facebook Pages.

Aim:

1. To ensure that the HRC Website and Facebook Pages adequately reflect the “Objectives of the HRC” as contained in the Constitution and
2. To assist the managers of those facilities in maintaining those standards.

Standards for operation of Discussion Forums

It should go without saying that the nature of material accepted for both the Website and the Facebook Pages should be compatible with the Objectives of the club as outlined in Item 1.2 of the Constitution of the Club.

The following guidelines should be followed:

- Discuss historic rallying
- Do not discuss modern rallying and cars less than 30 years old
- Maintain a respectable attitude to all within the sport
- Not raise complaints against other people or bodies
- Not maintain discussion on negative subjects

It is our responsibility to support the managers in maintaining these principles and remember always that we have set up these forums for the promotion of historic rallying. Discussion on other issues should not be encouraged, particularly where it takes up space and time that should be devoted to the primary causes.

Members of the Committee who are regular participants in these discussion groups can assist the managers by discouraging conversation on other issues.
